Buzzers and diawl bachs are still the best to catch on but as the trout are near the surface jumping and feeding it is worth noting for line depth that they are only a few feet down. I am stocking roughly once a week but don't be deceived in thinking it is always the same day. It has to vary



depending on when Bibury Trout Farm can deliver in this area as we are all trying to keep the prices the same and this is also reflected in fuel costs. So if I can receive them when they are coming by then it is helpful to all.


September Competition
